

Good afternoon everyone,

I promised to keep you informed about school arrangements for next week and beyond.

At this stage, no decisions have been made about whether schools will reopen for face-to-face teaching, remote learning or a combination of both.

Throughout this week the Director General is holding regular Webex briefings for Principals and therefore, once schooling provision is finalised, I will let you know.

This week, our teachers are working from home preparing for both face-to face and remote learning. They will continue to do this until school reopens for learning.

Over the next few days, class teachers will contact you by email to share information about the electronic platforms that will be used for communication and remote learning. Following a school pilot and feedback from both staff and parents in semester 2 last year, the following platforms will be implemented:

- Kindergarten – Year 2 SeeSaw
- Year 3 – Year 6 Connect

Please watch out for this email from the teachers so that you have this information should it be needed. Your child's class teacher is also available to be contacted by email should you have any questions.

In Monday's SchoolStream, I shared with you the Department's Learning from Home website should you wish to access this resource throughout the week.
