

Seesaw...


- Makes your child's thinking and learning visible, allowing us to see and celebrate their growth over time

- Gives your child an authentic audience for their work you, which motivates them to do their best













Logging in to Seesaw


Always log in to Seesaw using your parent account so that you can see the announcements, send messages to the teacher and comment on your child's work.

1. Go to https://app.seesaw.me on a computer. Or install the Seesaw Class App on an iOS or Android device.




2. Choose "I'm a Student"




Scan this code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in these letters to access your Seesaw account: VQFT CJRY JTTO FTRX








Class vs. Family App





- For teachers and students
- Students post to the journal and respond to activities
- Teachers post to the journal, assign activities, send announcements, and message families

Note: Group messaging is not available. Messages are between one teacher and one family member. Co-teachers cannot see each other's messages.

- For families
- Students <u>cannot</u> post to the journal or respond to activities
- Families view and engage with their child's journal and message the teacher

Note: The teacher must first send an announcement before families can message.

 Typed text (messages, comments, etc.) can be translated


